

Re: Fallowing Water Purchase Agreement Understanding

Dear Messrs. Michael and Avila:

Del Puerto Water District ("DPWD") and the San Luis Canal Company ("SLCC") entered into that certain Fallowing Water Purchase Agreement dated on or about September 22, 2022, together with that certain Fallowing Transfer Agreement dated on or about May 1, 2023, and Fallowing Transfer Agreement dated on or about May 31, 2024 which was entered into by and among DPWD, the "Authority", and the "Member Entities" (both as defined in the Agreement), and which was incorporated into the Purchase Agreement as Exhibit 'A'. The Fallowing Transfer Purchase Agreement and the Fallowing Transfer Agreement are referred to collectively in this letter amendment as the "Agreement".

Pursuant to the Agreement, DPWD is obligated to pay SLCC a sum to be determined annually pursuant to the formula identified in the Agreement in exchange for 2000 acrefeet of "Transfer Water" to be delivered to DPWD in San Luis Reservoir in years 2023, 2024 and 2025. Triangle T Water District ("TTWD") wishes to acquire the "Transfer Water" that is the subject of the Agreement in DPWD's stead for the 2024 year. Pursuant to this letter of understanding, DPWD, SLCC, and TTWD agree to the following:

- 1. Upon DPWD's annual payment to SLCC for the Transfer Water, SLCC shall make the Transfer Water available to TTWD in the San Luis Reservoir. DPWD and/or TTWD are responsible for all notices, approvals and additional costs for delivery from San Luis Reservoir.
- 2. DPWD and SLCC agree to continue to perform each of their respective obligations under the Agreement.
- 3. TTWD agrees to reimburse DPWD for the cost of the Transfer Water.
- 4. All terms and conditions of the Agreement remain unmodified and in full force and effect.

It is understood DPWD and TTWD intend to enter into other transfer agreements. DPWD and TTWD shall be solely responsible for all costs and securing all agency and regulatory

approvals, and required permits as are necessary and appropriate to transfer said water, including but not limited to CEQA and NEPA.

Please signify your agreement to the foregoing by signing in the space below. This letter of understanding may be signed in counterparts, each of which shall be an original.
